- 3. Explain how the morphology of a RBC is important for normal circulation
- 4. Videos about red blood cells in capillaries and make them understand the importance of blood flow.

1. Jelly-lemonade to tell why the blood is red. The jelly will be red and will represent the red blood cells: Sink the jelly in the lemonde: difference between red blood cells, white blood cells, plasma.

2. Blood flow: Use three straws to represent blood vessels. Close one of them in the middle with a rubber band, the other will be slightly closed, and the third open. Then let the children sip a raspberry juice to see how the blood flows easier in healthy vessels and that it's better to eat healthier.

3. Photos and videos of red blood cells smears in different diseases vs normal ones + making them produce RBCs in different shapes using red modeling clays.

First, I will tell the audience what is the blood, what are its components and why is it red. This is how I will start talking about the red blood cells(RBC). Then I will move to the roles of the RBCs, how they deliver oxygen and nutrients, etc.. This is why it's very important to have a good shape to be able to circulate and cross all the capilaries including the narrowest ones. I will show them that in some diseases, the red blood cells can have defectuous shapes that prevent them to circulate the way they should and this is what will cause a premature elimination of these cells from the circulation and this is how some people can suffer from anemia and other RBC- related diseases.
